 3. East Ridge Road East Pleasant St. from Main to Walnut
 4. S. Locust from W. Pleasant to W. Pike
 5. Penn Street from Water to Locust
 6. Short strip that connects N. Walnut to Waterworks/Abdallah Park
 7. Old Lair – Northside only from Elmarch to Brooks
 8. Grandview Drive
- Estimated cost \$92,500.00

Special Appropriations Projects:

1. Elmarch Avenue from Bridge to Stone
2. Lola Drive
3. Culpepper from approximately between 21 Culpepper and 250
Culpepper (not to include Cul-de-sac in front of 71 Culpepper)

Estimated cost \$86,200.00

Estimated Total Project: \$178,700.00
