Pleasant St. to Penn Street Bridge Street from Elmarch Ave. to the Covenant Presbyterian Church Church Street from Oddville Ave to Reynolds Ave Church Street from Pleasant Street to Pike Street Walnut Street from Mill Street to Pleasant Street On Elmarch Ave. from approximately 144 N. Elmarch Ave to Oddville Ave.</p>																			
<p>City Clerk McIlvain stated that Mayor Wells would now entertain comments from the public on the proposed use of the 2006-2007 Municipal Aid Road Funds and added that she had learned that paving costs had increased 20% to 25% since last year in the blacktopping product. Commissioner Doan questioned if the state has acted on the Governor's Discretionary Fund. Ms. McIlvain stated they have not acted on the applications that had been submitted for additional funds to pave city streets. Mayor Wells commented that she had received a call from Ms. Ginger Wills advising that the Department of Transportation will be in Cynthiana on July 17, 2006 to present a check to the City and the County governments. Hopefully, these funds can be used toward paving.</p>
