

SPECIAL MEETING  
SEPTEMBER 21, 2006

The City of Cynthiana Board of Commissioners met in a special session on September 21, 2006 following a public hearing at 4:15 P.M. Present were Mayor Wells, Commissioners Clayton, Commissioner Doan, and Commissioner Martin.

Mayor Wells advised the meeting was called in order to set tax rates for 2006 real and personal property, set the 2007 ad valorem tax rates, and have second reading of ordinance to adopt a zone change for 213 N. Main Street.

Clerk McIlvain read Ordinance #1423 fixing the tax rate at 14.0 cents on each and every \$100.00 worth of taxable read property and 21.0 cents on each and every \$100.00 worth of taxable personal and mixed property subject to taxes for city tax purposes in the City of Cynthiana, Kentucky.
