

August 6, 2007
Special Meeting

The City of Cynthiana Board of Commissioners met in a special session at CityHall on August 6, 2007 at 4:15 P.M. Present were Mayor Brown, Commissioners Doan, Keith, Martin and New.

Mayor Brown called the meeting to order and stated reason for meeting was to open bids on the 2007-2008 Municipal Road Aid paving.

MEETING CALLED
TO ORDER

One bid was received from Hinkle Contracting Corp:

Mayor Brown questioned about the milling. Tom Ralston of Hinkle said they would mill from curb to curb. Mr. Ralston also explained most of the streets flat.

Mayor Brown questioned where to store the milling, and stated that he did not want it stored at the Water Treatment Plant. Commissioner New will talk to Larry Williams, Public Works Supervisor, about where he thinks would be a good place to store the milling.

Commissioner Martin questioned about sidewalk depth at the street. Mr. Ralston advised that Hinkle tries to keep at 3".

Mayor Brown advised the City would wait on streets needing water line repairs, but the City plans to pave before the plant closes in the fall.

Mayor Brown asked Mr. Ralston if the quote from last year was still good on the streets left over from last year. Mr. Ralston stated that was correct.

Mr. Ralston stated the work could start next week. He questioned if the City wanted to pave to 62 on Meadow Lane. Mayor Brown stated the paving would go to the bridge on Meadow Lane. Mr. Ralston stated he would get with Commissioner New or one of his staff on manholes.

Commissioner New made a motion to accept bid from Hinkle Contracting Corporation as presented. Commissioner Martin seconded. In favor: Commissioner Doan: yes; Commissioner Keith: yes; Commissioner Martin: yes; Commissioner New: yes; Mayor Brown: yes; Opposed: none. Motion carried.
