

SPECIAL MEETING
SEPTEMBER 20, 2007

The City of Cynthiana Board of Commissioners met in a special session on September 20, 2007 at 3:30 P.M. for the purpose of setting the tax rates for 2007 and authorize the purchase of radios for Fire Dept. MEETING CALLED TO ORDER – PURPOSE STATED

Present were Mayor Brown, Attorney Lair, Commissioners Doan, Martin, and New. Commissioner Keith was absent.

Commissioner Martin explained the need for new pagers or radios in the Fire Department. Quotations have been sought and received on seventeen radios. The best quotation was from RCS for the Kenwood brand of radios.

Commissioner Martin made a motion to buy seventeen Kenwood TK-2170 brand radios from RCS at a cost of \$6,639.25. Commissioner New seconded. In favor: Commissioner Doan: yes; Commissioner Martin: yes; Commissioner New: yes; Mayor Brown: yes; Opposed: none. Motion carried. MOTION TO PURCHASE NEW RADIOS FOR FIRE DEPT.

Attorney Lair read Ordinance #1441 levying tax rate of .15 per \$100 on Real Property and .2458 Per \$100 on Personal and Mixed Property.

Attorney Lair read Ordinance #1442 levying an ad valorem tax rate of .16 Per \$100 on motor vehicles.
