

PUBLIC HEARING

The City of Cynthiana Board of Commissioners held a Public Hearing on August 26, 2008 at 5:15 P.M. in the Commissioner's Room at City Hall for the purpose of receiving comments regarding Municipal Road Aid Funds. Present were Mayor Brown, Attorney Lair, Commissioners Doan, Keith, Martin, and New.

1. Waterworks Rd. from old water Plant site to the Force Main Sewer
 2. Western Avenue from Parkway to Skyview
 3. Parkway
 4. Oxley Drive from Lola Drive to Pike Street
 5. Battle Grove Ave from Webster to Elmarch
 6. East Pearl St. From N. Church St. to CSX RR Crossing
 7. Stone Avenue from Elmarch Avenue to Spring-Dale Avenue
 8. North Locust from W. Pearl St. to W. Penn St.
 9. Rebel Hill

It was noted that every street on this list may not get paved. Commissioner Doan questioned if there was any indication from Hinkle about the cost. City Clerk replied that it cost \$26,500 to pave one parking lot, so that is a good indication that it is expensive.

Commissioner Doan also stated that he felt that the area where Confederate dead-ends should be included along with Rebel Hill. Commissioner Martin stated the cul-de-sac on Sonley needs to have work done also. Mayor Brown felt the City could repair this area.

Mayor Brown stated that if the bid comes in really high, the Board will have to prioritize the worst streets.

There being no comments or further discussion, Commissioner Keith made a motion to adjourn the public hearing. Commissioner Martin seconded. In favor: Commissioner Doan: yes; Commissioner Keith: yes; Commissioner Martin: yes; Commissioner New: yes; Opposed: none. Public hearing adjourned at 5:25 P.M.
