Mayor Keith stated the Public Hearing was now open and stated the Kentucky Governor's Office for Local Government is accepting applications under the 2010 Recreational Trails Program which is a federal grant program funded by the Federal Highway Administration. The City of Cynthiana and Harrison County Fiscal Court intend to apply for funding assistance to construct interior trails at Flat Run Veterans Park.

Harrison County Judge-executive Alex Barnett advised the County was in support of this application. He reported the proposed trails will connect the existing trails, the bottom half of the park and the parking lot.

SUPPORT

Tom Leith of Licking River Valley RC&D noted the projected cost of this project is \$65,500.00 with the City/County providing the 50% match. However, 3M has awarded a \$20,000.00 that will reduce the City/County cost to \$12,750.00.

Steve Moses, Magistrate, commented that these proposed trails fit in with the master plan and connect the Pavilion, playground equipment, and Farmers Market.

There being no further comments, Mayor Keith closed the hearing at 5:12 P.M.
