PLASTICS



Acceptable Plastics are:

#1, #2, #3, #4, & #5

PET Bottles (polyethylene terephthalate) – Clear and colored plastic containers such as soda, liquor, and other items. (Labeled as **#1**)

HDPE Bottles labeled as **#2** (high density polyethylene) – Unclear and colored plastic containers used for milk, water, juice, detergents, and other items.

Also take **#3, #4, #5.**

RINSE THOROUGHLY – Especially milk jugs. Remove all caps and flatten to conserve space in your recycling container.

LEGACY CANNOT RECYCLE:

Plastic toys or any other household plastics.

NO Styrofoam!!

METAL CANS



You may recycle all empty cans and lids, whether aluminum, bi-metal (aluminum & steel), or steel. Included are beverage cans, food cans, pet food cans, etc. We also accept clean aluminum foil.

RINSE OUT beverage cans and **WASH OUT** food cans (remove all food particles).

LEGACY CANNOT RECYCLE: Paint cans, aerosol cans, large pieces of metal, or cans that are not empty.

PAPER



We accept **NEWSPAPER**. Can also recycle magazines & glossy inserts. **CORRUGATED CARDBOARD** is acceptable if it is broken down (flattened & tied in bundles). We also accept **BROWN PAPER BAGS**.

LEGACY CANNOT RECYCLE:

Cardboard with plastic lamination or foil.

When you recycle, you can feel good about the fact that you are doing something positive. The small steps you take when sorting out your trash really helps to reduce landfill waste.

DID YOU KNOW?...

Recycling newspaper reduces the number of trees that need to be cut down. Recycling just one ton of newspaper can save twenty trees.

Recycling aluminum saves energy and resources. Recycling one aluminum can saves the energy equivalent of ½ can of gasoline.

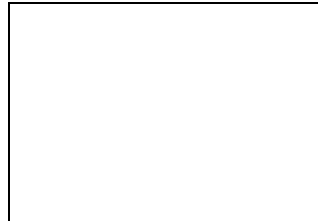
Tin cans are actually 99% steel and 1% tin. The steel strengthens the can, and the tin coats the inside and outside to prevent corrosion. Every year Americans throw out enough steel to reconstruct Manhattan. Tin cans take 100 years to turn to dust. The iron ore and tin are valuable minerals and nonrenewable resources. They are too valuable to take up space in landfills.

For your convenience, a black recycling container is provided to city residents by Legacy Carting. This container remains the property of Legacy Carting, so leave it at your home if you move. Then the next resident can recycle, too!
